

**ESSENTIAL CONTENT & SKILLS:**

Students will study the German language with equal emphasis on listening, reading, speaking, writing, and culture. **German 2** content includes:

First Semester:

- Chores
- Clothing and shopping
- Food vocabulary; ordering food
- Audio Play: Keine Panik

Second Semester:

- Obtaining a driver’s license and driving in Europe
- Buildings and types of businesses
- Directions
- Travel

Throughout both semesters:

- Grammar – **Verbs:** verb conjugation, modal verbs, separable prefix verbs, conversational past tense; **Cases:** accusative and dative cases; **Prepositions:** accusative, dative and 2 way prepositions
- German, Swiss, and Austrian cultures (holidays, dialect, etc...)
